



ID: Unique identifier that WAMPO assigns to track the project through the TIP process

Lead Agency: The managing organization or government entity. The lead agency is often the owner/operator of the project/facility.

Title: Unique name given to describe the project. If it is a capital construction project, it usually includes the project location.

Project Type:

- Bridge – Highway
- Bridge – Other road
- Interchange

- Ped/Bike

Total Cost : Current cost estimate to complete the project; it includes the costs for pre-construction activities. Between when the project is initially listed in the TIP and when it's constructed/implemented, the cost estimate can change significantly due to estimates being updated during the development process.

Fed Funds: If federal funding is programmed for the project, this shows the specific funding programs:

EARMARK: Federal legislation that includes an individually listed project

MPO-CMAQ: [Congestion Mitigation Air Quality program](#)

Intended for use on projects that improve traffic congestion and/or air quality in areas designated non-attainment for regulated air pollutants. Because the WAMPO region is in attainment for all of the regulated pollutants, it is used for the same purposes as the Surface Transportation Program (STP). In the WAMPO region, this program is awarded by WAMPO.

FTA 5307: [Federal Transit Administration Urbanized Area Formula program](#)

Used for transit capital improvements, maintenance, operations, and planning assistance for mass transportation in urbanized areas. In the WAMPO region, Wichita Transit administers this program.

FTA 5310: [Federal Transit Administration Enhanced Mobility of Seniors & Individuals with Disabilities program](#)

Provides formula funding to states and metropolitan areas for the purpose of assisting private nonprofit groups in meeting the transportation needs of older adults and people with disabilities when the transportation service provided is unavailable, insufficient, or inappropriate to meeting these needs. In the WAMPO region, Wichita Transit manages the urbanized portion of this program and KDOT manages the rural portion of the program. In the WAMPO region, Wichita Transit administers this program.

FTA 5339: [Federal Transit Administration Bus & Bus Facilities Infrastructure Investment program](#)

Used to replace, rehabilitate, and purchase buses and related equipment and construct bus-related facilities. In the WAMPO region, this program is used by Wichita Transit.

HSIP: [Highway Safety Improvement Program](#)

Used for projects that are intended to improve the safety of the traveling public. In the WAMPO region, this program is used/awarded by the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT).

KDOT- HIF: [Highway Infrastructure Program \(awarded by KDOT\)](#)

Used to construct roads, bridges, and tunnels along the federal aid highway/road system.

NHPP: [National Highway Performance Program](#)

Used by States to assist in achieving the targets for the condition and performance of the National Highway System. In the WAMPO region, this program is used by the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT).

KDOT-STP: [Surface Transportation Block Grant Program \(used /awarded by KDOT\)](#)

Used for a wide variety of transportation projects which include, but are not limited to, road improvements, bridge improvements, transit, technology, planning, and safety.

MPO- STP: [Surface Transportation Block Grant Program \(awarded by WAMPO\)](#)

Used for a wide variety of transportation projects which include, but are not limited to, road improvements, bridge improvements, transit, technology, planning, and safety.

MPO-TA: [Transportation Alternatives](#)

Used for bicycle and pedestrian projects, including, but not limited to, on- and off-road pedestrian and bicycle facilities, recreational trail program projects, and Safe Routes to School type projects. In the WAMPO region, this program is awarded by WAMPO.

MPO- HIF: [Highway Infrastructure Program \(awarded by WAMPO\)](#)

Used to construct roads, bridges, and tunnels along the federal aid highway/road system.

Fed: Percentage of the total cost of the project programmed/budgeted with federal funding.

State: Percentage of the total cost of the project programmed/budgeted with State of Kansas funding thru the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT).

Loc: Proportion of the total cost of the project programmed/budgeted with funding provided by local governments (e.g., cities and counties) in the WAMPO region.
