



FFY: Federal fiscal year programmed / budgeted

Federal Fiscal Year is the accounting period for the federal government. The federal fiscal year runs from October 1 thru September 30. It is named for the calendar year in place during the January – September portion of the federal fiscal year.

Source: Funding source programmed / budgeted

State: Amount of State of Kansas funding thru the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) that is programmed / budgeted for the project

Local: Amount of local government funding that is programmed / budgeted for the project. Often the local government funding is provided by the lead agency

EARMARK: Amount of federal funding programmed / budgeted thru federal legislation that includes individually listed projects

MPO-CMAQ: Amount of federal funding programmed / budgeted with [Congestion Mitigation Air Quality](#)

FTA 5307: Amount of federal funding programmed / budgeted with [Federal Transit Administration Urbanized Area Formula Program](#)
