



ID: Unique identifier that WAMPO assigns to track the project through the TIP process

Lead Agency: The managing organization or government entity. The lead agency is often the owner/operator of the project/facility.

Title: Unique name given to describe the project. If it is a capital construction project, it usually includes the project location.

Limits: If applicable, geographic location and/or extent of the project

Proposed Work: Summary of the project scope of work

KDOT ID: Unique identifier that the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) assigns to track the project through the KDOT project development, construction, and reimbursement processes.

Total Cost: Current cost estimate to complete the project; it includes the costs for pre-construction activities.

PE: Preliminary Engineering

ROW: Right of Way Acquisition

UT: Utility Relocation

CON: Construction

CE: Construction Engineering

OP: Operations (Transit projects only)

IMP: Implementation (Transit, Planning, and Outreach projects only)

FFY: Federal Fiscal Year is the accounting period for the federal government. The federal fiscal year runs from October 1 thru September 30. It is named for the calendar year in place during the January – September portion of the federal fiscal year.

Prior FFY: Costs programmed / budgeted for federal fiscal years previous to the years the current TIP covers.

FFY2019: Costs programmed/budgeted for federal fiscal year 2019 (October 1, 2018 – September 30, 2019)

FFY2020: Costs programmed/budgeted for federal fiscal year 2020 (October 1, 2019 – September 30, 2020)

FFY2021: Costs programmed/budgeted for federal fiscal year 2021 (October 1, 2020 – September 30, 2021)

FFY2022: Costs programmed/budgeted for federal fiscal year 2022 (October 1, 2021 – September 30, 2022)

FFY2023: Costs programmed/budgeted for federal fiscal year 2023 (October 1, 2022 – September 30, 2023)

Future FFY: Costs programmed / budgeted for federal fiscal years after the years the current TIP covers.
